



How Does the Treatment Work?

The treatment is conducted by making a regular pattern of closely spaced dots. These 5mm circles are interspaced with 3mm skin bridges within the tattoo design. A proprietary fluid (consisting of all natural ingredients) is dispensed into these circles and acts to seize the tattoo pigment in the deeper layers. Subsequent healing of these areas, followed by in-filling of the 3mm bridges at a suitable time interval (minimum 8 weeks) eliminates the tattoo design. The average size tattoo (15cm x 15cm) typically takes between 3-5 treatments, depending on the design, amount of pigment and other factors, including laser treatments and location of the tattoo.

The treatment works equally well on cosmetic tattoos, where an inappropriate colour in eyebrows have turned blue/purple, or faded to chalky/yellow. A mistake made on a lip line can be removed, without damaging melanocytes. Most cosmetic tattoo removals can be completed in 1 - 2 treatments.

Tatt2Away PRE-Treatment Instructions

Please read the following carefully and ask your practitioner questions about any aspect of the Tatt2Away procedure you do not understand.

1. Tatt2Away of TEPR (Trans Epidermal Pigment Release) is a new system for tattoo removal. TEPR is a highly effective system for removing tattoos and semi-permanent make-up. The procedure is performed only by highly trained professionals.
2. Tatt2Away removal techniques target all colours, ages, sizes and styles of tattoo and only natural products are used for pigment removal. However, we recommend that the maximum size of an individual tattoo to be removed is no larger than 15cm x 15cm (6"x6").
3. You must follow our post treatment guidelines exactly to obtain the best possible result. This includes following the home care instructions, attending follow up appointments, and use of silicone sheeting. If you do not follow these instructions exactly, you may not achieve the best possible results.
4. Fully trained and certified personnel carry out all treatments. A numbing topical may be used to minimise any discomfort. The upper layers of the skin containing the tattoo pigment are treated in a similar way to the method used to apply your original tattoo. A special fluid is delivered into the tattoo pigment using tiny medical grade micro needles.
5. The TEPR technique causes the tattoo pigment to rise to the surface during the healing process in the form of scabs. These scabs then fall off over a period of two weeks taking the ink with them.
6. Because the body is sensitive and naturally regenerative we need to give the treated areas their own time to recover to normal before working on an adjacent area. This is a minimum of 8 weeks, depending on how your body controls the healing process.
7. It is important to remember that we do not treat all the tattoo design in a single session. This allows the area of treatment to heal correctly and reduces the chances of scarring. The process is repeated until the entire tattoo has been treated and removed. During your consultation, we will estimate how many treatments are required to remove your tattoo.
8. If you have already attempted removal of your tattoo using a laser technique, we will carefully evaluate the condition of your skin relative to your potential for success. Based on previous laser treatments, you may not be a candidate for tattoo removal using TEPR.
9. Several small tattoos can be treated at the same time. Appointments are restricted to one hour maximum.

Before your TEPR treatment visit

Two days before treatment — use a good quality body scrub exfoliation product to remove dead skin cells in the area of the tattoo removal.

If any hair is growing over the tattoo, do not shave the area — we will do this immediately prior to your treatment session.

Electrolysis should not be done with 5 days of the procedure. Do not resume any method of hair removal for 1 week after the procedure.
